AquaFarm 2020 leaves Brussels

The top event for aquaculture and sustainable fishing for Southern Europe and the Mediterranean is at SeaFood Global Expo in Brussels to present the new dates and the programme for the fourth edition, on 19th and 20th February 2020 at Pordenone Fiere.

Pordenone, 8th May 2019. AquaFarm 2020, the event at the Fiera di Pordenone dedicated to aquaculture and sustainable fishing, is at the SeaFood Global Expo 2019 from 7th to 9th May in the area for the Friuli Venezia Giulia region within the Italy stand curated by the MIPAAFT (Italian Ministry for Food, Farming, Forestry and Tourism Policies).

AquaFarm, which in the space of three years has become the leading event for workers in the entire "from the water to the table" supply chain, of Southern Europe and the Mediterranean, is taking part in a busy schedule of meetings in Brussels, to present the new edition, planned for the 19th and 20th February next year, again in collaboration with the API and AMA, the two leading Italian associations for aquaculturists and shellfish cultivators.

The leading role in the **2020 edition**, at the request of exhibitors and visitors, will be taken by the end product: producers will talk about their products and let you try them, with the opportunity for tasting sessions; a large "fish and seafood market" will be set up along with a business lounge dedicated to B2B meetings with buyers from the sector. The aim is to promote awareness of the Italian product from aquaculture and sustainable fishing to operators in the supply chain of transformation, distribution, and individual and collective catering.

AquaFarm 2020 will once again run alongside NovelFarm, an international exhibition-convention completely dedicated to innovation in agritech, with detailed studies into acquaponics, the integrated production of aquatic plants and species, and the circular economy.
